 - Figuring out how to create an infrastructure for IM fellowships through the experience for the Academic Consortium's fellowship recognition committee which Dr. Konigsberg chairs. This can inform the structure of a fellowship which may be suitable for the Royal College.
 - University of Arizona has a 500-hour fellowship curriculum that can be leased by a fellowship which would help with the didactic portion of the curriculum. The cost is \$10,000USD/fellow.
 - U of. Saskatchewan has an IM center and may be a good option for housing a fellowship. They have expressed initial interest.
 - Dr. Nahas had mentioned a new initiative in Ottawa which could potentially provide infrastructure for a fellowship– need more details.
 - U of BC and U of Manitoba have the IM residency programs. We can reach out to them in regard to a fellowship as well.
